Learn to Skate FAQS

What class do I sign up for?

If you have never skated before or have never had any formal training, we recommend starting in the following classes: Snowplow Sam 1 for ages 3-6; Basic 1 for ages 7-16; Adult 1 for Adults ages 17+.

What is the class progression?

After S.S. 1, ages 3-6 advance to S.S. 2-4 and then to Basic 2. After Basic 1, ages 7-16 advance to Basic 2-6 levels, then onto Pre-Freeskate & Freeskate 1-6 levels.

What do I need to wear?

Please wear warm, comfortable, layered clothing including gloves and thin socks. Helmets are recommended.
