What do I need to wear?

Wear warm, comfortable, layered clothing including gloves and thin socks. Helmets are recommended for new skaters. Wear long pants only (no shorts).

What do I need to do the first day? Please

arrive 30 min prior to the start time of your first class. Staff will help you with your rental skates and guide you where to go. Be ready to have fun!

Can I make up a missed class? If you miss a class, please contact our staff about scheduling a make up time. Make ups must be completed within two weeks of missing a class.

Can I get a refund? We have a no refund policy on classes; however, we can hold your credit to be used at a later date or within your family.

What is the Sports Accident Insurance? All skaters are required to pay \$16 annual (July 1– June 30) membership fees to Learn to Skate (LTS) USA prior to registering for classes. This is paid at <u>www.learntoskateusa.com</u>. Have the membership number when registering for classes. This provides the skater with liability insurance during classes. Additionally, skaters receive fun items such as a practice book and magazine. LTS USA is endorsed by US Figure Skating, USA Hockey, US Speedskating, and the Special Olympics.
