#### Which class is best for new skaters?

Ages 3-6: Snowplow Sam 1

Ages 7-16: Basic 1 Ages 17+: Adult 1

#### What do I need to wear?

Wear warm, comfortable, layered clothing including gloves and thin socks. Helmets are recommended for new skaters. Wear long pants only (no shorts).

#### How and when do I sign up?

# **BEGINNER & INTERMEDIATE**

30 mins | 5 weeks | \$67.50

In our beginner classes, skaters will learn basic fundamentals, including standing up, falling down, forward & backward skating, gliding, and stopping. Classes may be combined if there are not enough skaters enrolled 48 hours in advance. Intermediate classes continue to build upon the foundation taught in the beginning levels. These classes include free public sessions over the duration of the session! Come out and practice to develop your skills!
