#### Which class is best for new skaters?

#### What is the class progression?

Snowplow 1 > Snowplow 2-3 > Basic 2-8 Basic 1 > Basic 2-6> Free Skate 1-6 Adult 1 > Adult 2-6 > Free Skate 1-6

#### What do I need to wear?

Wear warm, comfortable, layered clothing including gloves and thin socks. Helmets are recommended for new skaters. Wear long pants only (no shorts)

#### How and when do I sign up?

Register early to ensure your spot. Please register at least 3 days before the first day of class.

### What do I need to do the first day?

### Can I make up a missed class?

If you miss a class, please contact Tatum Neustadt about scheduling a make up time. **Make ups must be completed within one week of missing a class**.
