Which class is best for new skaters?

Ages 3-6: Snowplow Sam 1

Ages 7-16: Basic 1

Ages 17+: Adult 1

What is the class progression?

Snowplow 1 > Snowplow 2-3 > Basic 2-8

Basic 1 > Basic 2-6 > Free Skate 1-6

Adult 1 > Adult 2-6 > Free Skate 1-6

What do I need to wear?

Wear warm, comfortable, layered clothing including gloves and thin socks. Helmets are recommended for new skaters. Wear long pants only (no shorts)

How and when do I sign up?

Register early to ensure your spot. Please register at least 3 days before the first day of class.

What do I need to do the first day?

Please arrive **30 min** prior to the start time of your first class. Staff will help you with your rental skates and guide you where to go. Be ready to have fun!

Can I make up a missed class?

If you miss a class, please contact our staff about scheduling a make up time. **Make ups must be completed within one week of missing a class.**

Can I get a refund?

We have a no refund policy on classes; however, we can hold your credit to be used at a later date or within your family.

Class Benefits!

Unlimited public sessions passes added to Skater's account over the duration of classes (Snowplow, Adult, Basic and Theater on Ice)

Advanced skaters receives eight freestyle passes that expire the end of each session. (Pre- Free Skate, Free Skate and Axel Class only)

Bonus practice ice during the opposite time block (contingent on ice space; priority given to classes)

An official U.S. Figure Skating Basic Skills membership card

USFS Sports Accident Insurance

All skaters are required to pay \$16 annual (July 1- June 30) membership fees to U.S. Figure Skating. This provides the skater with liability insurance during classes. Additionally, skaters receive fun items such as a practice book and magazine.

Multiple Class & Family Discounts

Sign up for more than one class and receive 50% off each additional class that session!

If immediate family sign up for classes, the 2nd family member receives 20% off the session, the 3rd member receives 30% off, etc.

THEATER ON ICE

Basic 6 and up:

Sunday 2:10pm– 3:10pm

Fun way to learn and work in a themed group program setting. Theater on ice class is formed to learn how to use choreography and body movement of the arms on and off the ice. Participants will learn synchronized footwork and theater performances.

CONDITIONING OFF ICE CLASS

Saturday 10:15am–10:45am:

This class is offered before Learn to skate. Conditioning Off ice training is a 30 minute quick workout before getting on the ice for your regular Learn to Skate classes. This class is great for learning proper stretches and workouts before stepping on the ice.
